The City of Hialeah announces a public hearing to which all interested parties are invited.

PURPOSE: To obtain public comments on the housing and community development needs for the City of Hialeah's 5-Year Consolidated Plan. This is the planning document for the following federal programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and Home Investment Partnership (HOME). It covers a five-year period beginning October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015. The Plan contains specific elements including: an assessment of housing and homeless needs for the ensuing 5-year period; Hialeah's housing data; a discussion of Hialeah's strategies, priority needs and objectives for housing and community development activities; and a One-Year Action Plan that describes the City's distribution of funds to carry out activities using funds that are expected to be received under formula allocations.

Written comments are also encouraged and may be submitted at the hearing or mailed to the Department of Grants and Human Services, 501 Palm Avenue, Hialeah, FL, 33010 (Attention: Frederick H. Marinelli, Director) and post marked no later than June 15, 2010, at 5:00 p.m.
