FIU Student Chapters of NAWIC and ABC Visited Hialeah: On October 29, 2008, the Florida International University student chapters of the National Association of Women in Construction joined by the Associated Builders & Contractors visited Hialeah in order to take a site tour of Fire Station No. 6, which is under construction.
