These units were obtained through a Department of Homeland Security Grant named. Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI). The emergency

vehicles are specially designed to support chemical, biological, nuclear, and explosive missions throughout the State. The Hialeah Fire Department will be putting two fire engines in service which are specially designed to mitigate chemical emergencies and two rescue units equipped with a filtration system to transport contaminated patients.
